

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Active Adult Parklets



The design provides for two multi-use paved areas in the Active Adult parklets:

- Sitting and Gaming Area
- Labyrinth Area


These areas can be set up for:

Active Adult Parklets and Precedent Imagery














The Grove

- Lawn Games


Other recreational activities and features include:




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Park Street Trellis Seating Area



The center of the park street is punctuated by a decorative plaza area flanked by two trellised seating areas.

A linear open space and trail, running north and south crosses the park street at this point. Raised crosswalks in a contrasting paving color and texture alert motorists of the crossing.


The space provides a gathering area for community events, block parties, art shows, etc. The plaza provides a level surface for temporary tents, tables and shade structures.

The permanent benches and trellises provide a comfortable passive recreational area adjacent to an open lawn area.

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
Park Street Trellis Seating Area and Precedent Imagery







Fire Circle Gathering Area




Crushed granite paving and moveable seating lends an informal air to this gathering area on the east end of the park street. The fire pit will surely become a focal point for evening gatherings.

Since this block is close to the town center, it may become another meeting spot for shop and restaurant patrons, or a place for barbeques (on portable grills) and food fairs.

The adjacent lawn area allows for flexible programming, and additional features that the HOA may install to meet the residents' recreational needs.





The Rose Garden




The Rose Garden provides a focal point at the terminus of the main north-south boulevard street. It is located in one of the Community Parks.

The shape is influenced by classically designed formal gardens, utilizing a raised bed for the roses and crushed granite paving surface. The oval form was used for its clean lines.

Generous seating is provided by curved benches. Formal evergreen shrubs and other seasonal plantings complete the arrangement.





The Clock Tower in the Village Green



The Clock Tower provides an easily recognizable focal point for one of the village greens.

The clock is centered on two of the roads approaching the intersection. Seasonal plantings further highlight the arrival to the town center.

This is a formal space with cobblestone-like paving and ample seating, and provides a great meeting place for people patronizing the village shops and restaurants.

The Town Center



New Hanover Town Center is organized around a central green. The one-way circulation pattern and parallel parking spaces and raised cross walks calm traffic. The village green will serve many functions:

- Town center
- Event space for street fairs
- Landscaped buffer between buildings
- Gathering place
- Passive recreation
- Limited active recreation
- Gazebo/bandshell
- Seasonal outdoor cafe
